The Midwest Museum of American Art is pleased to announce the 32nd Elkhart Juried Regional Art Exhibition, October 8 - December 5, 2010. This all-media competition is open to artists 18 years and older who are residents of Allen, DeKalb, Elkhart, Fulton, Jasper, Kosciusko, Lake, LaGrange, LaPorte, Marshall, Newton, Noble, Porter, Pulaski, St. Joseph, Starke, Steuben or Whitley counties in Indiana and Berrien, Cass or St. Joseph counties in Michigan. Each entrant may submit one (1) or two (2) works which must be original in concept and execution, created within the last two (2) years, not completed under instruction and not previously exhibited at the Midwest Museum or any other competition within the region.

All works must be hand delivered September 11 through (cont.)

ENTRIES DUE (continued):

September 25 during special museum hours: Mon.-Fri., 9:00AM - 5:00PM or Sat. & Sun., 1:00PM-4:00PM.

ENTRY FEE:

\$25.00 entitles entrant to submit one entry. \$40 for two entries. Entry fee is non-refundable. Limit up to (2) works.

SIZE LIMITATIONS:

Length or width may not exceed seven (7) feet. No work of art may exceed 100 lbs. in weight.

FRAMING & PRESENTATION:

All entries must be prepared for installation. Two-dimensional work must be framed and wired for hanging. Three-dimensional work should be self-supporting or be able to be placed on a pedestal. No installation pieces accepted. No works will be accepted that require the artist present for installation.

PICK-UP of ACCEPTED and NOT ACCEPTED WORKS:

Non-accepted work must be picked-up September 28 through October 3 during regular museum hours, Tues.-Fri., 10:00AM to 4:00PM, or Sat. & Sun., 1:00PM-4:00PM

Accepted works must remain for the duration of the exhibition and may then be picked up December 6 through December 30, 2010. All work not claimed by January 9, 2011 will then automatically be considered the property of the Midwest Museum of American Art to dispose of in any way it sees fit.

RESPONSIBILITY:

All works accepted for the exhibition will be insured by the museum.

SALE OF WORK:

Unless otherwise indicated by the artist, all work is for sale. A commission of 25% on work sold is payable to the Midwest Museum. There is no commission fee on Purchase Awards.

AWARDS RECEPTION:

All submitting artists, friends and museum members are invited to attend an Awards Reception on Friday evening, October 8, from 7:00-9:00PM.

JURORS:

The distinguished jurors for the exhibition will be Jacqueline Moses, Painter, Chicago and Nick Antonakis, Painter & Professor of Art & Chairman of the Art Department, Grand Rapids Community College, Michigan.

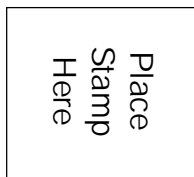

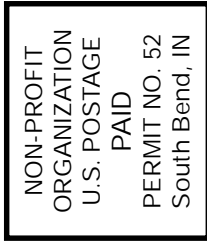
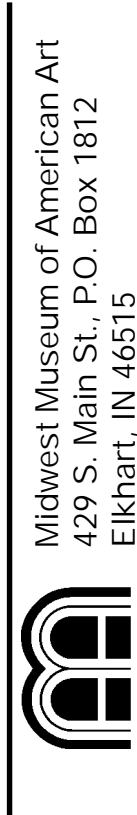
